OBJECTIVÉS

- 1. To provide command and operational control of all elements of the New Jersey National Guard.
- 2. To plan for and establish the force structure required to accomplish both federal and State missions while supporting the future goals established by the Governor for the development of the State.
- To recruit, train and support the personnel required by the force structure to be able to respond to calls to duty by federal and State authorities in the event of an emergency.
- 4. To operate, maintain, and preserve and extend the useful life of all physical facilities required for the housing, support and training of the New Jersey National Guard.
- 5. To evaluate and determine priorities for the location and construction of new facilities and the expansion and improvement of existing facilities in order to support the force structure of the National Guard.
- 6. To operate and maintain the Joint Training Center at Sea Girt for National Guard and State Police training programs.
- 7. To operate and maintain a High Technology Training Center at Fort Dix, New Jersey in order to provide the enhanced state of the art individual and unit training required by the members of the New Jersey National Guard and the members of other reserve and active component military personnel in order to insure their ability to survive on the modern battlefield.

Program Classifications

- O1. National Guard Training Operations and Administration—Provides operational control and administrative support to the State National Guard, whose objectives include the protection of life and property and the preservation of peace, order, and public safety during any state of emergency or disaster. In addition, the federally mandated objective is to provide military units and individuals in time of national emergency when national security may require augmentation of the active military forces.
- 02. Management of National Guard Installations—includes all activities related to armory operations, maintenance, alteration, expansion and construction of installations required for troop housing, training, storage, and security of equipment. Operating and maintenance costs for facilities other than armories, such as warehouses, maintenance facilities, etc., are supported by federal funds ranging from 75% to 100% of such costs.
- 03. Management of Joint Training Center—The Training Center at Sea Girt provides accommodations for year—round weekend training and annual two—week summer training periods for National Guard personnel. The Center is also utilized by the Division of State Police for special in-service and recruit training as well as for basic police training of county and municipal law enforcement personnel. Additionally, the New Jersey State Fire College conducts specialized training for volunteer fire department personnel from throughout the State.
